VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS AND UNIFORM INFORMATION:

Volunteers are required to pay a uniform fee of \$25 for one (1) golf shirt and one (1) cap or visor. For your generous donation you will receive a package valued at over \$350 which consists of one volunteer badge, volunteer lapel pin, ticket book (Fri.-Sun.), lunch & beverages provided on days worked, volunteer parking pass, shuttle service, and you are encouraged to attend our Volunteer Appreciation Party on Saturday, Oct. 25, immediately after play in the hospitality tent. This party is exclusively for volunteers. While working you must wear the official AT&T Championship uniform. Each volunteer must wear khaki pants, golf length shorts or capri's. Once you have been assigned to a committee, your committee chairman will be in contact with you to finalize your schedule in the weeks prior to the tournament and provide you with detailed information pertaining to your duties, responsibilities, meetings, credentials and uniform distribution.

PAYMENT:

Payment is accepted by **AMERICAN EXPRESS, MASTERCARD, VISA, CHECK or MONEY ORDER** and made payable to **AT&T CHAMPIONSHIP**. If for any reason you are unable to work, you must return the entire, unused uniform package to the Tournament Office, prior to the event, in order to receive a refund.

GOLF APPRECIATION DAY:

To qualify for Golf Appreciation Day (GAD), with a shared cart, you must work a minimum of 18 hours and purchase a volunteer uniform for \$25. Golf shoes must be spikeless and a dress code is enforced.

VOLUNTEER COMMITTEES:

- **ADMISSIONS/WILL CALL:** Check tickets, oversee Will Call, provide information and assistance to all patrons, sell tournament programs & distribute pairings sheets. (Monday - Sunday)
- **CADDIES:** Hospitality for pro caddies including registration and distribution of caddie bibs and towels
- **CARTS:** Inventory, maintenance and distribution of carts to tournament staff & officials
- **LASER OPERATORS:** Fairway - Be a part of the Shotlink scoring system. Measure players' shots using a laser at the edge of the fairway/green. TRAINING SESSION IS MANDATORY. (Wednesday - Sunday)
- **LEADERBOARDS:** Bird's-eye view of the tournament and the finishing round on 18. Receive top 10 leaders' scores via radio then post hole-by-hole scores on leaderboards. (Friday - Sunday)
- **MARSHALS:** Responsible for gallery control on each hole and major traffic areas on course. Marshals not working with a specific group or hole will be placed on a non spectator hole as a spotter for the pros/amateurs. (Wednesday - Sunday)
- **MEDIA CENTER:** Assist with hospitality for all local and national media. (Monday - Sunday)
- **PARKING:** Transport spectators from off course parking lots & assist bringing elderly and physically challenged on-course *
- **PRO-AM:** Hospitality and package distribution for amateurs competing in Pro-Ams on Monday, Wednesday & Thursday
- **PRO WIVES HOSPITALITY:** Hospitality for Champions Tour wives (Monday-Sunday)
- **REFRESHER:** Distribution of ice/ water/beverages/ fruit/candy on tee boxes **
- **SHUTTLES:** Transport spectators and assist bringing elderly and physically challenged on-course * (Monday-Sunday)
- **SIGNAGE:** Responsible for setup and take down of all tournament signs.
- **SPONSOR HOSPITALITY:** Hospitality and concierge services for corporate sponsors in tents and skyboxes (Friday-Sunday)
- **STANDARD BEARERS (JUNIOR):** Needed for the Pro-Am on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. There is no fee for this committee. You will receive a t-shirt, golf cap and badge good for admission all week. You must be between the ages of 14-17 and be able to carry a five pound standard for 18 holes. ** This committee will not receive the GAD complimentary golf round.
- **STANDARD BEARERS:** Accompany each group of players for 18 holes with a sign to identify golfers and their scores, which are updated after each hole. The standard weighs approx. five pounds.** (Monday & Wednesday - Sunday)
- **STRIKE FORCE:** Servicing players on driving range, putting green and other on-course areas
- **TELEVISION:** Work on-course and in conjunction with The Golf Channel to help secure audio and video for television broadcast. Must be a knowledgeable golfer and able to walk 18 holes. ** (Friday - Sunday)
- **TOURNAMENT OFFICE:** General office operation duties prior to and during the tournament (mailings, phones, etc.)
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Airport and hotel pick-up and drop-off of Pros, TOUR Officials and Pro-Am contestants before, during and after event week as needed. Must be at least 18 years old. * & ** & ***
- **WALKING SCORERS:** Scorers walk with each group of professionals and maintain statistics as well as hole-by-hole records for each player using the Shot link hand-held Palm device. Champions Tour staff will provide comprehensive training prior to tournament days. TRAINING SESSION IS MANDATORY. (Wednesday-Sunday).
